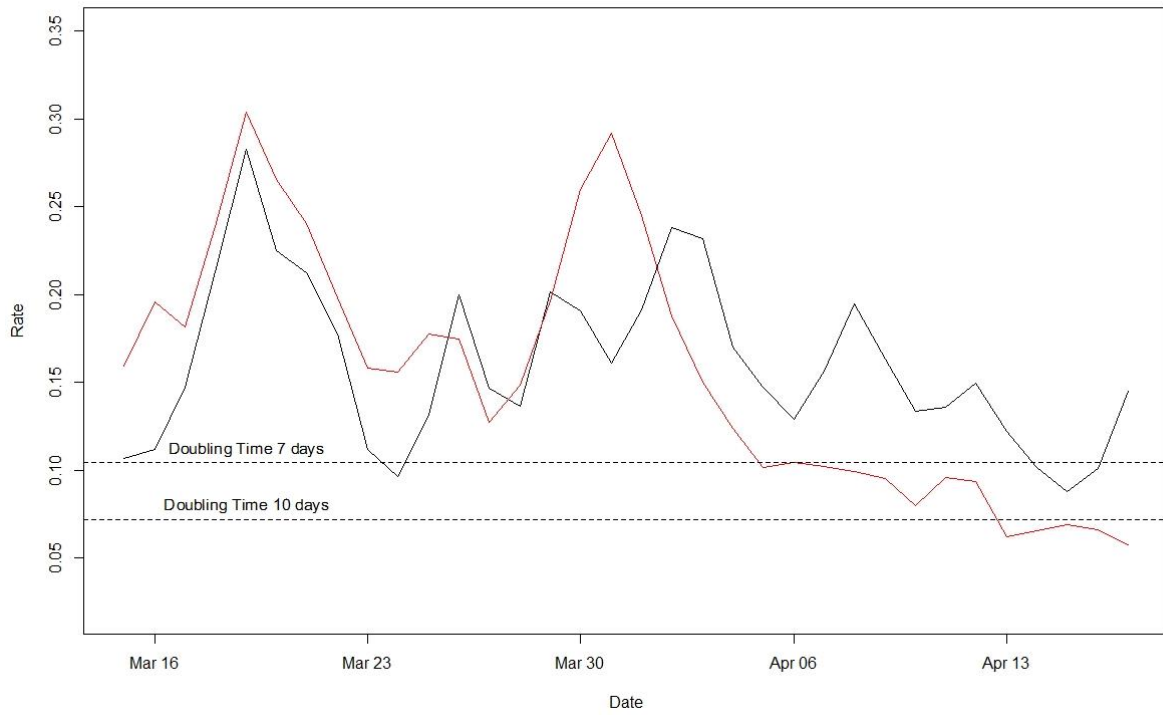


HOW DO INDIAN STATES COMPARE?



The rate, defined as the ratio of the number of new cases to the number of existing cases, is plotted. The black line is for the states of Maharashtra, Gujarat, Rajasthan and UP. Together, these states make up for 49% of the total cases. The red line is for the rest of the states.

There is a clear separation.

The rate, for the rest of India, has stayed below 7-day doubling for 10 days in a row.

A two-day smoothing has been applied on the rates to make the plot cleaner, although the general conclusions remain same without smoothing.
